Recap of Last Month's Meeting

March Meeting Highlights

- A final fundraising push to make up for the ~\$12,000 budget shortfall was discussed. The PTO does have reserve funds stemming from COVID times, but a possible use of these surplus funds is to fund a project that will benefit CHS and its students.
- Dr. Gutchewsky gave an update on the Long-Range Planning process: Paragon presented varying options to the BOE, who now are considering them. Improvements to CHS that are being reviewed include designated space for the robotics team, a dedicated Student Services Suite (nurse, counseling, Wellness Center, school resource office, SSD classrooms), major updates to the Black Box theater, and even moving Gay Field closer to the CHS campus.
- T'Shon Young's activites update included info about the Senior Day of Service and this year's prom.
- More Faculty/Staff Special Projects Awards were announced, including funding a special Senior Issue of the Globe Student Magazine focusing on the senior class and funding build and study materials supporting Brad Buck's Science Olympiad team.
