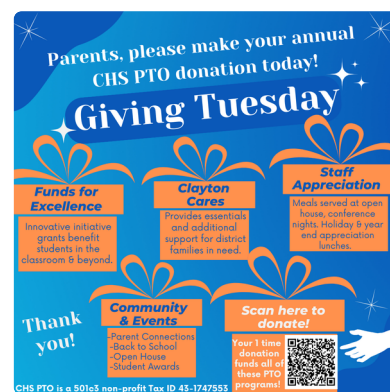

An urgent message to busy CHS Parents,

Thank you to those who participated in Giving Tuesday or donated earlier in the school year! The PTO budget this year is \$29,650, a \$2,000 increase over last year. It is entirely thanks to incredible volunteers that we can accomplish so much on this modest budget. Unfortunately, as of today, we have only received approximately \$10,000 in parent donations, with nearly \$19,000 remaining to reach the target. Each year, CHS Parents come through by year end, so let's jump ahead to the results, instead of spending our limited resources on reminders and fundraising pleas til year end. December is a busy month for everyone. 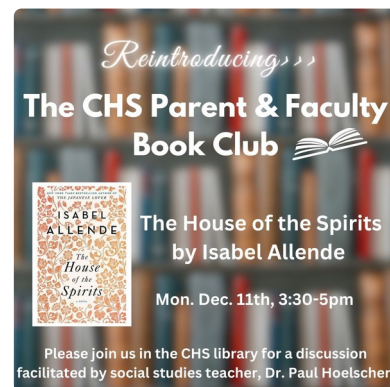


Mark Your Calendar
