Recap of Last Month's Meeting

October PTO Meeting Highlights

- Our last PTO meeting kicked off the October Funds for Excellence campaign. Families are encouraged to donate to fund PTO events and projects; approximately 27% of our operating budget has been raised thus far. Our CARE Fund, which supports community members in need, is about 50% funded.
- Dr. Gutchewsky shared details about the recent school threats and the amazing job local law enforcement and first responders did in responding to them; he reiterated that student and staff safety is always the number one concern. Adults were reminded to use the front door to enter the building and never ask students to let them in.





- T'Shon Young shared information about upcoming Homecoming activities for students and families, and the Committee Chairs reported on the meals and snacks that will be provided to support teachers and staff during the month of October.
- Parent questions on the topics of cell phone use, the recent bomb/social media threats, and attendance were answered.
