

#### **September Meeting Minutes**

At our last PTO meeting, Superintendent Dr. Nisha Patel shared the progress being made on developing a new long-range Master Facilities Plan for the District, information about the new Centegix badges for all staff to use in emergencies, and all the recent updates to Clayton High School facilities. The Clayton PTO's Mission Statement was reviewed, and plans were shared for the upcoming Funds for Excellence Fundraising Campaign. The 2024-2025 proposed budget was reviewed and the status of donations was shared. Principal Gutchewsky shared more information about how enforcement of the existing CHS cell phone policy was going and further details about how the new attendance policy will work. Coordinator of Sports and Activities T'Shon Young gave updates about activities and events for Homecoming weekend, student clubs, and exciting wins for the football and volleyball teams. Details about upcoming events for Homecoming Weekend, Staff Appreciation, and Parent Connections Social Events were highlighted.
