

Community Alliance for Healthy Kids' Wydown Middle School Social Activities Program

Each year parents of WMS students volunteer in cooperation with the Community Alliance, WMS staff and administration, and the Clayton Parks and Recreation Department to offer three fun activities for WMS students at each grade level. 6th Grade

- Winter Lock-In at the Center of Clayton, 7:30 – 10:00 on a Sat. night
- Spring BBQ

GUIDELINES

To respect the time of our parent and staff volunteers and to ensure that the activity is fun and safe for everyone:

- Participants should arrive promptly but not before the scheduled time.
- Everyone must sign in upon arrival.
- Please pick up your child promptly at the designated ending time. Chaperones are volunteers and are asked to stay for only 20 minutes after the event ends.
- If your child is leaving with a friend, please send a note explaining the pick up arrangement.
- Serious misbehavior such as fighting, shoving, use of foul language, leaving the premises, or property damage may result in immediate and permanent dismissal from future social programs. Parents will be called to pick up their child.
- The Community Alliance discipline policy follows the Wydown Code of Conduct. The parent chaperones are in charge and will determine the rules for a particular event.
- Tobacco, alcohol, and other drugs are prohibited. The possession or use of such substances will result in immediate dismissal from that activity and future activities. Parents will be called to pick up their child.
- No guests are allowed without prior approval by the event chairperson. Outside guests will be limited to out-of-town friends or family.
- If a participant needs to leave the event before its completion, the parents will need to come into the event and pick up their child.
