- About 20% of teens will suffer from depression at some time before reaching adulthood.
- More 15-19 year olds die from suicide than the top 8 medical causes of death combined.
- It is estimated that 1 in 12 college students have made a suicide plan.
- For every completed suicide by youth, it is estimated that 100-200 attempts are made.
- Did you know that in 2008, 17% of our 8th graders, 8% of our 9th graders and 9% of our 11th graders seriously considered suicide in the past year according to the Youth Risk Behavior Student Survey taken at WMS and CHS?
- This issue will impact your child, family member or friend.
