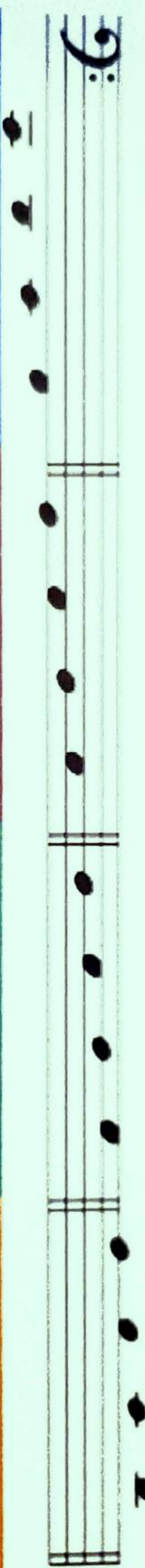


This Cello Fingering Chart shows the finger to use for each note above the stave, and the note name and string below the stave.
