## **Genetics**

Third grade scientists should be able to understand that some characteristics of organisms are inherited from parents and, some characteristics are influenced by the environment.

### **Phenotypes**

Phenotypes are the physical characteristics of organisms. These physical characteristics are passed on genetically (from a mother and father) *and* can be affected by an organism's environment.
