6th Grade WEB Orientation Invitation



Hello, families of new 6th Graders! We are very excited that your child will be attending Wydown Middle School, and we look forward to meeting them during 6th Grade Orientation on Thursday, Aug. 18. Our school has chosen to participate in the nationwide WEB Program, an organization that helps sixth graders feel comfortable and achieve success in their first year of middle school. WEB stands for "Where Everybody Belongs," and helps students find their place at Wydown.

The purpose of this program is to make the transition from elementary school to middle school a positive one. Each student will be assigned an 8th Grade WEB Leader that will serve as a mentor and resource during their first year. During orientation, students will meet their WEB Leaders and participate in a variety of large and small group activities designed to address students' needs and concerns in a safe, fun, and enjoyable manner.

Sixth-graders should wear comfortable clothes for this student-only event. Travel light - please leave your backpacks and cell phones at home. Sixth-graders will return to Wydown with their families for Sixth-Grade Walk-Through at 5 pm.

PowerSchool Forms Need to be Completed

The required forms for the 2022-2023 school year are now available in PowerSchool.

These forms must be resubmitted every year before the first day of school.

Completion of the forms enables your child to retain access to their google account and continued chromebook usage. Completed forms are required to view your child's 22-23 class schedule when they become available in August.

If you are newly enrolled and will be attending Wydown for the first time this fall, look for an email from our registrar, Steffie Stout. This email describes how to set up your parent portal in PowerSchool. If you need technical assistance, please contact the Help Desk by emailing techsupport@claytonschools.net or call 314-854-6033.

Please be sure to complete both the parent and student forms in PowerSchool by **Friday, Aug. 12, 2022**. All forms will need to be completed, along with any fines paid and books returned, to have access to your child's schedule. Schedules will be available on Monday, Aug. 15, in PowerSchool. It may be difficult to complete these forms on a phone app, a computer may be needed. The forms are located in your PowerSchool account under the "navigation" tab on the left-hand side. **These forms also need to be completed to insure receiving communication from the District and school (such as newsletters, memos, emergency phone messages, inclement weather notifications, etc.) at the correct email address and phone number.**
